Built on a green-field site in Melbourne, the versatile multi-pack lines cater to the new generation of wine-in-a-can products, in addition to a range of beverages including RTD's, beers, fruit juices, ice teas, energy drinks and soft drinks.

The state-of-the-art project features large volume output of 30,000 cans/hr and 15,000 bottles/hr, on a floor space of 3,600sq/mtr. With the challenges of working in a difficult environment whilst the green-field site was still under construction, the installation met strategic timelines and commissioned under full production conditions.

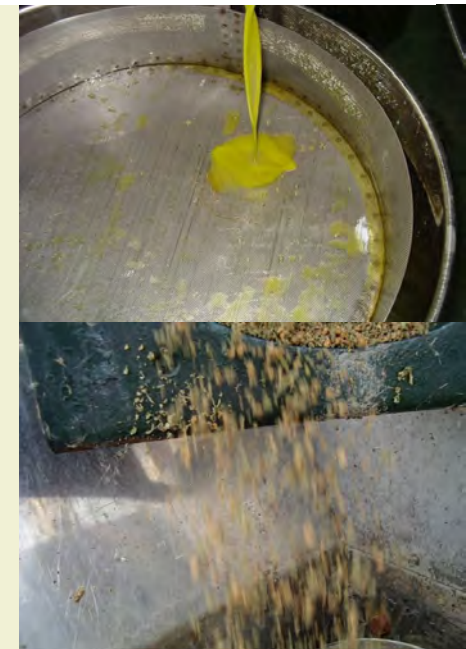
THE FLYING HORSE BAR & BREWERY

The Flying Horse Bar & Brewery in Warrnambool Victoria, opened in July 2008. The boutique brewery installation was as a turnkey solution - FB*PROPAK supplied a skid mounted 10HL Pub Brew system with mash/lauter, HLT combo vessel and kettle/whirlpool vessel. The installation included a glycol chilling unit, steam boiler, grain mill with auger and keg washing/filling unit, three 1000L FV and two 1200L Bright beer tanks.

The stainless steel, steam powered and manually operated brewery is a classic single infusion design, which roughly translated means that it can produce over 2500 pots of beer. Winner of the prestigious Champion Porter trophy and Gold Medal at the 2009 Australian International Beer Awards, the brewery is actively working on growing distribution of its beers both domestically and in overseas markets.

MURRADOC OIL PROCESSORS

Murradoc Oil Processors initially purchased the Pegaso 500 and then upgraded in 2006 to the OMT X15 super decanter and 1.5/hr press with 4 x 700kg malaxes. Murradoc Oil Processors and their Lighthouse Extra Virgin Olive Oil brand, is a multi-award winning olive oil, grown and cold pressed on Victoria's Bellarine Peninsula, with 11,000 trees grown on 165 acres





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
