The Series 19000 carbonating system is designed and manufactured to meet the special requirements of small and medium size breweries. The polished stainless steel units are available as assemblies, consisting of carbonating stones with associated holders and gaskets. The unit can be attached to the tank wall with a tri-clamp or can be used with any other Zahm & Nagel connection. Optionally, an arm extension can be used to place the carbonating stone further into the tank. Used in either configuration, the unit is easily accessible from the outside of the tank when a tri-clamp (model 19000 TC) is welded to the unit or the arm extension. The assembled unit can be simply and completely disassembled for cleaning. The units come equipped with the unique Zahm check valve that prevents beer back-up into CO gas supply lines. External adapters may be attached to connect with any CO system.

The Zahm D.T. Piercing Device is used to test carbonated beverages for volumes of CO2 gas in glass/PET bottles and cans. This instrument uses a dual scale pressure gauge (0-60 psi & 0-4.2kg/cm2) and an adjustable 2" dial thermometer (25/125°F & - 5/55°C). It is available in one and three litre sizes. The Series 6000 Piercing Device will provide rapid and accurate determination of gas volumes in alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages when used with the two pressure/temperature charts furnished with the instrument.

Volume Meter

The Zahm SS-60 Volume Meter was developed to determine average CO2 levels of gas in tank stored beverages. A must have piece of equipment in any brewery. A precise piston release mechanism eliminates bleeding off of the sample and the potential for human error. Samples undergo repeatable, precise volumetric expansion test after test for more accurate measurements. The lightweight design reduces operator fatigue while the stainless steel construction increases strength and resists corrosion. The thermometer may also be replaced in the field without the need to return it to the factory for replacement.
